Job Title: Chemical Dependency Counselor
Department: Behavioral Health – AOD Program
Reports To: Community Support Clinical Director
FLSA Status: Non-Exempt (Bargaining Unit)

SUMMARY: This position is designed to provide substance abuse treatment to individuals dually diagnosed with mental illness as the primary diagnosis and a secondary diagnosis of substance related disorders. Under the supervision of a community support program clinical supervisor/director, devotes at least twenty (20) hours per week to group and individual counseling with clients of the CARES program.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include the following

The person will serve as the primary substance abuse counselor to a cohesive open group of dually disordered individuals. Works with a co-facilitator to provide group counseling three times a week and individual counseling. Participates in weekly interdisciplinary treatment team meetings. Builds and maintains a therapeutic relationship with each person served. Provides group educational sessions for clients and family that are informative and engages the participants. Provides evidence in progress notes for each clinical contact. Makes the person served aware that she/he is part of a team of professionals working to improve sobriety, decrease relapse, maintain mental health, and achieve desired goals, and program outcomes.

Must maintain current state licensure/certification to function as an approved CD practitioner. Abide by rules and regulations set forth by CSWMFT and OCDPB boards of Ohio.

QUALIFICATIONS: Bachelor's degree in social services or related field. At least four years or more of experience preferred, with LCDC III or higher licensure. Must be available to see clients during critical times, including evening and weekends. Must have a valid Ohio driver's license with less than four (4) points on driving record, a working vehicle, and current automobile insurance which meets state minimum requirements.
