APPROVAL OF FAITH-BASED OUTREACH COMMITTEE ACTION PLAN

WHEREAS, Phase 1 of the proposed Action Plan was reviewed and unanimously approved by the Faith-based Outreach Committee at its meeting on May 1, 2013; and,

WHEREAS, the Faith-based Outreach Committee has reviewed and approved the attached Action Plan and recommends its approval to the full Board.
