## APPROVAL OF AMENDMENT TO RESOLUTION NO. 15-11-05 CY2016 ADAMHS BOARD OPERATIONAL BUDGET AND CY2016 – 2017 SERVICE PROVIDER CONTRACTS

- c. CY2016: Provider Direct Services Budget \$56,472,322.00 (\$2,073,807 Increase From Original Budget Amount of \$54,398,515)
- d. <u>CY2016: Other Behavioral Health Services Budget \$3,168,000.00 (No Change From Original Budget)</u>
- e. <u>CY2016</u>: Opportunities for Ohioans With Disabilities (OOD) FFY2017 Case Service Contract \$1,515,582.00 (No Change From Current Budget)

**WHEREAS,** the ADAMHS Board Finance and Operations Committee has reviewed the proposed increased CY 2016 budget and recommends that the Board of Directors adopt said amendment.
