WHEREAS, the West Side Catholic Center will continue to serve as the fiscal agent for the Identification Crisis Collaborative whose mission is to assist low income individuals living with mental illness or substance abuse obtain State identifications and related proofs of citizenship; and.

WHEREAS, the Finance and Operations Committee reviewed the need for the above referenced operational agreement and recommends that the Board of Directors approve said agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- A. The ADAMHS Board of Directors approves the following operational and administrative contract/agreement:
 - 1. Identification Crisis Collaborative (IDCC)
 - West Side Catholic Center \$48,000.00
- B. The ADAMHS Board Acting Chief Executive Officer is hereby authorized to execute and make payments pursuant to the terms of the contract/agreement, subject to the availability of funds.
