**ADAMHS BOARD SUPPORT OF OHIOMHAS SFY19/20 COMMUNITY
CAPITAL PLAN PROJECT SUBMISSIONS**

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Mental Health & Addiction Services (OhioMHAS) requested a SFY19/20 Community Capital Plan to identify capital projects that focus on the creation of additional permanent supportive housing to benefit clients living with mental illness and/or addiction; and,

WHEREAS, OhioMHAS issued an additional request for Youth Resiliency Capital projects; and,

WHEREAS, the ADAMHS Board is supporting the following capital projects being reviewed by OhioMHAS:

- Recovery Housing Capital Project requested by I'm In Transition Ministries for the purchase and renovation of the NOAH House for men living in recovery from opioid addiction
- Youth Resiliency Capital Project requested by Northern Ohio Recovery Association (NORA) for the purchase of the Connecting Youth Through Recovery Drop-in Center to provide recovery and support services for youth and their families; and,

WHEREAS, OhioMHAS requests a resolution from the ADAMHS Board of Cuyahoga County to provide support for capital projects being considered for funding; and,

WHEREAS, the ADAMHS Board's Planning and Oversight Committee reviewed Board staff's recommendation and recommends supporting the identified Youth Resiliency and Recovery Housing Capital Projects being considered for funding by OhioMHAS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The ADAMHS Board of Directors supports the SFY19/20 OhioMHAS Capital funding requests for NORA's Connecting Youth Through Recovery Drop-in Center and I'm In Transition Ministries' NOAH House.
