APPROVAL OF FENTANYL AWARENESS CAMPAIGN

WHEREAS, Cuyahoga County continues to experience the devastating effects of the opioid crisis and the deadly impact of the synthetic opioid, fentanyl; and,

WHEREAS, Fentanyl is the leading cause of drug overdose death in Cuyahoga County and is now being discovered in a myriad of drugs; and,

WHEREAS, overdose deaths reported in the community that can be attributed to fentanyl are disproportionately affecting African American males in the city of Cleveland and the inner ring east side suburbs; and,

WHEREAS, Fentanyl is often mixed with other drugs without the user's knowledge; and,

WHEREAS, a targeted campaign will raise public awareness of the dangers of using heroin and fentanyl; and,

WHEREAS, the ADAMHS Board's Finance and Operations Committee reviewed Board staff's recommendation and recommends launching a Fentanyl Awareness Campaign to run June 2019 and July 2019 in targeted media platforms.
