The following list identifies activities that the Consolidated Board will need to accomplish to support an efficient and fully functioning Board on July 1, 2009. This list would help frame a structured work plan for the Consolidated Board. Decisions would be made on a provisional basis in most situations and then ratified on July 1, 2009.

- 1. Adopt by-laws
- 2. Select officers
- 3. Establish Ad Hoc Committees supporting consolidation including purpose and membership
- 4. Assign members to standing committees of new Board
- 5. Identify role for current Board members that will not be on new Board
- 6. Identify areas requiring participation and approval by current Boards
- 7. Select CEO/Executive Director
- 8. Approve contracts for administrative office space
- 9. Approve selected policies and procedures related to operations

- 10. Select a name for the new Board
- 11. Approve budget
- 12. Orient/prepare Board members for new responsibilities
- 13. Obtain information/input from stakeholders and experts
- 14. Communicate to community on consolidation
- 15. Advocate on various issues related to consolidation
