WHEREAS, The ADAMHS Board Committee of the Whole reviewed the proposed plan and recommends that the Board of Directors approve and ratify the plan that was submitted to OhioMHAS on the required deadline of October 14, 2021; and,

WHEREAS, The Board's Community Capital Plan and prioritization of projects can be amended each SFY as needed and requested by OhioMHAS
