**APPROVAL OF STATE LEGISLATURE CAPITAL ASSISTANCE
APPLICATIONS FOR APPLEWOOD CENTERS, INC. JONES HOME CAMPUS
RENOVATION (MH-1232) & CHILDREN'S AID SOCIETY
CAMPUS RENOVATION (MH-1243)**

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio Assurances Statement requires the ADAMHS Board to assure the buildings will be used for the purposes described in the applications unless written authorization is obtained from the State; and,

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio Assurances Statement also requires the ADAMHS Board to approve the applications with an assurance of an intent to support the applicant's programs consistent with the applications and, in addition, to annually monitor the programs and operations of the facilities; and,

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio requests a resolution from the ADAMHS Board to support the following projects:

1. PROJECT MH-1232, Applewood Centers, Inc. Jones Home Campus Renovation: Renovate the residential facility and outpatient treatment building on the Jones Home Campus located at 3518 W. 25th Street, Cleveland, Ohio 44109; and
2. PROJECT MH-1243, Applewood Centers, Inc. Children's Aid Society Renovation: Renovate the two buildings on the Children's Aid Society Campus located at 10427 Detroit Avenue, Cleveland Ohio 44102.

WHEREAS, the ADAMHS Board's Planning and Oversight Committee reviewed Board staff's recommendation and recommends support for Projects MH-1232 & MH-1243 that is being considered for funding by State Legislature.
