Committee of the Whole Discussion

Committee

- A subset of a board assigned by appointment to investigate certain matters of importance
- Does not carry with it the powers of the entire board but can only carry out the functions that are prescribed to them by the board

Committee of the Whole

- Different from a regular committee because it includes all of the directors from each committee up to all of the directors
- Allows all of the directors from each committee up to all of the directors an
 opportunity to engage in informal discussion on ideas and proposals which may
 eventually result in a recommendation to the board
- Formal rules of debate such as the number of times and how long a member can speak are modified or dispensed altogether
- May or may not take the place of other standing committees
- ADAMHS Board utilizes the committee of the whole during the July, October and November board cycles to replace other standing committees

Consent Agenda

- Matters that are discussed and passed in committee, including the committee of the whole, may utilize a consent agenda in the full board meeting
- Streamlines meeting procedures by collecting routine, non-controversial items into a group whereby all are passed with a single motion and vote
 - o i.e., Contracts, Contract Amendments, etc.
