WHEREAS, funding has been made available to the Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services Board of Cuyahoga County (ADAMHS Board) for the following programs:

1. The Devereaux Student Strengths Assessment (DESSA) Tool Usage Renewal for the 2023-2024 School Year for the time period for the time period August 1, 2023 to July 31, 2024 in the amount of \$8,885.00 for the following contract:
 - a. Aperture Education Services; and,
2. OhioMHAS: Specialized Docket Support – Payroll Subsidy for the time period July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024 in the amount of \$455,000 for the following contracts:
 - a. Cleveland Municipal Court - \$200,000.00
 - b. Cuyahoga County Common Pleas Court - \$210,000.00
 - c. South Euclid Municipal Court - \$45,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, the ADAMHS Board staff recommends that the Board of Directors accept the funding and authorize the ADAMHS Board to pay any required local match and enter into any necessary contractual agreements.

- A. The ADAMHS Board of Directors accepts the funds and authorizes payment of any required local match for the following:
 1. The Devereaux Student Strengths Assessment (DESSA) Tool Usage Renewal for the 2023-2024 School Year for the time period for the time period August 1, 2023 to July 31, 2024 in the amount of \$8,885.00 for the following contract:
 - a. Aperture Education Services; and,
 2. OhioMHAS: Specialized Docket Support – Payroll Subsidy for the time period July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024 in the amount of \$455,000 for the following contracts:
 - a. Cleveland Municipal Court - \$200,000.00
 - b. Cuyahoga County Common Pleas Court - \$210,000.00
 - c. South Euclid Municipal Court - \$45,000.00.
- B. The ADAMHS Board Chief Executive Officer is authorized to execute any necessary contractual agreements.
