Sub-Acute Detoxification

Withdrawal Management offers short-term residential care (ASAM 3.7) with medical staff on-site 24/7. The Sub-Acute medical treatment facilitates safe withdrawal from opioids (including Suboxone), alcohol, and/or benzodiazepines. Detoxification usually lasts 3-7 days, with Suboxone treatment lasting longer. While receiving medical care, each individual works with a counselor to determine the next steps in recovery, such as residential treatment, medication-assisted treatment (MAT), outpatient services, community recovery supports, or a combination of services. Clients who have completed medical detox are able to remain in Harbor Light Interim Housing (ASAM 3.1) while arranging for further treatment. Individuals who do not require detox (for example, using cocaine or methamphetamine) can be admitted directly to the 3.1 level of care. Counselors assist clients with linkage to services.

Cigarette smoking is permitted at scheduled times in designated areas.

Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP)

The Intensive Outpatient Program (ASAM 2.1) is a comprehensive day treatment program based on the stages of change model. Services are provided to adults in early recovery by skilled chemical dependency counselors.

The IOP process starts with a Screening, completed either over the phone or in person, to collect basis information.

completed either over the phone or in person, to collect basic information regarding the client's substance use history and demographic information. If the individual is eligible for services, an assessment will be scheduled to determine the client's needs and appropriate level of care. The assessment/intake usually last about two hours.

IOP Schedule

Group therapy consists of 18 sessions over a six-week period. Harbor Light offers morning and afternoon sessions (8-11:00 AM or 1-4:00 PM) on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays.



Attendance at community support meetings (AA/NA, Smart Recovery, faith-based groups) is required twice weekly for successful completion of IOP. Once weekly Aftercare groups (ASAM 1.0) are provided following completion of IOP as a relapse prevention support.

IOP Group Topics

Intensive Outpatient group sessions focus of the following topics:

- The Brain and Addiction
 - Stages of Change
 - Thinking Errors
- Cognitive Behavioral Interventions
- Community Recovery Supports
- Relapse Prevention Strategies
