APPROVAL OF EMPLOYEE SALARY INCREASE OF OAPSE, AFSCME LOCAL 4 & LOCAL 328

WHEREAS, the Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services (ADAMHS) Board of Cuyahoga County and the Ohio Association of Public School Employees (OAPSE)/AFSCME Local 4, and its Local 328, are parties to a Collective Bargaining Agreement effective January 1, 2017, through December 31, 2019; and,

WHEREAS, the collective bargaining agreement provides for reopening the agreement "to address the subject of Article 25 (Wages), only, for contract years 2018 and 2019; and,

WHEREAS, the ADAMHS Board and OAPSE have reopened the subject of Article 25 (Wages) for 2019 and have concluded negotiations over the reopener for wages; and,

WHEREAS, the parties agree that the collective bargaining agreement between OAPSE and the ADAMHS Board shall be modified to provide for a two percent (2%) wage increase for all bargaining unit employees effective as of January 1, 2019; and,

WHEREAS, the ADAMHS Board Finance & Operations Committee has reviewed the negotiated salary increase for 2019 for OAPSE, AFSCME Local 4 & Local 328 and recommends that the Board of Directors approve the agreed upon salary increase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. A 2% salary increase is approved for contract year 2019 for staff covered under the collective bargaining agreement.
- 2. The ADAMHS Board Chief Executive Officer is authorized to execute said Agreement.
