- 1. The ADAMHS Board of Directors adopts the 2010 Advocacy Action Agenda to guide its advocacy efforts throughout 2010.
- 2. The ADAMHS Board of Directors authorizes the Chief Executive Officer to distribute the 2010 Advocacy Action Agenda to the community.
