AUTHORIZATION TO ISSUE A REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP) FOR MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES FOR THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY DETENTION CENTER PROJECT

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services Board of Cuyahoga County (ADAMHS Board) Board of Directors Policy entitled "Awarding Contracts for Services," effective March 24, 2010, the ADAMHS Board is to issue Requests for Proposals (RFP) or Requests for Information (RFI) upon the request of ADAMHS Board staff regarding mental health, AoD and other service needs; and,

WHEREAS, the Alcohol Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services Board of Cuyahoga County through an agreement with the Cuyahoga County Juvenile Court is seeking to provide mental health crisis stabilization and support treatment services in juvenile detention center services commencing January 01, 2012 through December 31, 2012; and,

WHEREAS, the primary goal of the program is to provide mental health crisis stabilization and support treatment services for juvenile detention offenders referred by the Cuyahoga County Juvenile Court Department; and,

WHEREAS, the coordination of mental health crisis stabilization and support treatment services role within the Juvenile Court Detention Center is germane to its success; and, more importantly, it ensures adherence to the structure of the model which sets the foundation to meet programmatic outcomes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- The ADAMHS Board of Directors approves the issuance of an RFP to solicit applications from ADAMHS Board contracted behavioral health care providers to provide crisis stabilization and support treatment services within the Juvenile Court Detention Center Treatment program from January 01, 2012, through December 31, 2012.
- 2. The ADAMHS Board CEO is hereby authorized to appoint the RFP Committee to review and evaluate the RFP proposals that are submitted for recommendation to the Board of Directors.
